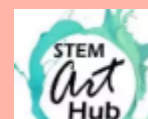
Preet Sahota

DRAW & CHAT!

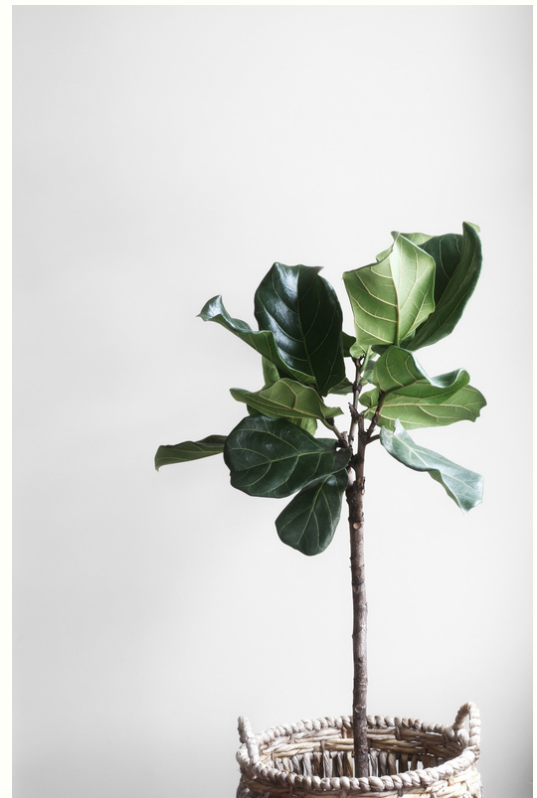

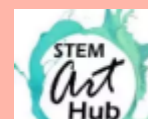
